Dear Mr. Leong,

I have the honour to invite your organization to attend as an observer the fifty-second session of the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL). In accordance with practice established in UNCITRAL, invited international non-governmental organizations may attend the session as observers, with a delegation of up to five persons, and be given an opportunity to present their views on matters where the organization concerned has expertise or international experience so as to facilitate the deliberations at the session.

The session will open on **Monday, 8 July 2019, at 10 a.m. at the Vienna International Centre**. After consultations with States that are members of UNCITRAL as at 8 July 2019 and in the light of the expected workload of the Commission at its fifty-second session, it has been found that a two-week session should be sufficient to address the agenda of the Commission at its fifty-second session. The originally scheduled dates of the session (8-26 July 2019) (see A/73/17, para. 283) have therefore been changed to **8 to 19 July 2019**.

I should be grateful if you would kindly inform me **no later than 27 June 2019** whether your organization intends to attend the session of the Commission and, if so, by whom it will be represented. Each delegate's individual e-mail address should be included. The provision of an e-mail address will ensure that each member of the delegation receives an automatic e-mail response confirming registration. The e-mail response will contain a link to enable the participant to upload his or her photograph (JPG format) for use on the security pass for entry to the Vienna International Centre. Participants who are not able to avail themselves of this facility will have their photograph taken in the Pass Office of the Vienna International Centre upon arrival.

It would be appreciated if the above deadline is adhered to, in order to facilitate entry of your delegation to the Vienna International Centre and avoid delay in completing security procedures.
